Right to lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner

Any person can request the Information Commissioner to make an assessment if they believe that they are/have been adversely affected by the handling of personal data by Cheshire Fire and Rescue Service. Such requests should be made directly to the Information Commissioner.

The <u>Information Commissioner</u> is the independent regulator responsible for enforcing the Act and can provide useful information about the Act's requirements. The Information Commissioner's Office may be contacted at the following address:
