

PROTECT YOUR BUSINESS FROM ARSON

Don't become a victim

What to look for:

Small fires, antisocial behaviour, vandalism or fly tipping - these could all be signs of worse crime to come. Liaise with your local Police Community Support Officer (PCSO) and ask your staff to report any suspicious activity to you.



What to do

Most attacks happen at night so make sure:

- Your building is secure
- All fire doors and all windows are closed
- Your alarm system is activated
- Any waste is either inside or in a lockable bin, which is stored away from the building where possible
- Security lighting is on and day gate locked

Keep your fire risk assessment up to date:

- Ensure that you test any detection equipment you may have
- Test and service extinguishers and sprinkler systems
- Download our free Fire Safety Logbook from our website
- Follow us on twitter and facebook for up to the minute information on incidents in your area - details are on the back of this leaflet

Of the **875 fires in non-domestic premises** (commercial and public buildings), in the five year period between 2014/15 and 2019/20, **217** fires (**24.8 per cent**) were due to **arson**.

Cheshire Fire and Rescue Service is the Enforcing Authority for the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 in Cheshire.

A dedicated Business Safety team actively works with businesses to ensure they are compliant with the above legislation, and ensure they stay safe from the risk of fire. 1.	Is there a history of vandalism or fire setting in the area around the premises?		
2.	Are there serious crime problems in the locality of your business?		
3.	Have you suffered more than two arson attacks in the past three years?		
4.	Have you suffered more than 10 incidences of vandalism in the past 12 months?		
5.	Have you experienced more than five incidences of theft or break-ins during the past 12 months?

6.	Is security lighting provided?		
7.	Is a CCTV system installed?		
8.	Are all external doors, rooflights and windows secured out of business hours?		
9.	Do letter boxes have metal containers on the inside to contain lighted rags, paper or fireworks?		
10.	Do staff monitor customer or visitor movements?

11.	Is waste regularly removed by the local authority or a contractor?		
12.	Are waste containers locked when not in use?		
13.	Are waste containers secured so they cannot be moved and placed against the property?

14.	Is your business fitted with smoke alarms or other means to give early warning of fire?		

Any of the highlighted areas receiving a tick will require a control measure to be put in place to reduce the risk of an arson attack.
